HEALTHCARE



Good Health and Well Being is identified as one of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).



Under its CSR initiative of FSL, efforts are put in to make good health affordable and accessible to the local communities and the society at large. As part of this, FSL has been conducting specialized health camps and have been providing healthcare facilities to the community.

The backbone of any society is healthy populace who are both physically and mentally fit. Since its inception, FSL has been carrying out need based health interventions which are not only curative, but also preventive in nature. FSL is regularly contributing towards various medical associations, which are indulged in providing medication

and financial support to the needy people who cannot afford their treatment.

In regions susceptible to low levels of healthcare, either due to shortage of qualified medical personnel or due to the prevalence of stigma associated with certain health conditions, FSL offers quality medical advice and healthcare by conducting various medical camps. Eligible cases that require referral services to super specialty hospitals are identified and assisted to get the best possible medical services. Around 500 people were benefitted by the medical camps organized by the Company.



Emergency Ambulance service



The company has made provision of Emergency Ambulance service (24 x 7 facilities) for the people of peripheral villages across all the locations of operations and taking care of its repair and maintenance on regular basis.

Through the emergency ambulance service, immediate access to medical facilities is ensured to the villagers for accidental cases, emergency and delivery cases.

School and Community Toilets Embracing the Gandhian ideology of “Sanitation for all”, the Government of India, in its biggest and most recent cleanliness drive, launched the “Swachh Bharat Mission” to make India open defecation free by 2019 by constructing adequate toilets for all. FSL has taken up this initiative of the Government of India in constructing toilets for communities and schools at large. The Company’s goal is to make a visible impact on the health and hygiene of children, their families and communities by improving, their health and hygiene practices as well as the supporting infrastructure.



Clean, accessible water for all is an essential need for healthy living. There is sufficient fresh water on the planet to achieve this. But due to bad economics or poor infrastructure, every year millions of people, most of them are children, die from diseases associated with inadequate water supply, sanitation and hygiene. FSL, in its endeavor to ensure clean and safe drinking water and adequate sanitation infrastructure, has taken up a number of initiatives and measures in this regard.

EDUCATION & SKILL DEVELOPMENT



Fortune Stones Limited recognizes education as one of the building blocks of the nation and thus considers it an important area for its CSR initiatives. FSL seeks to support and supplement state efforts to strengthen quality mass education in local government schools. FSL's aim is to nurture and educate young minds so that they contribute to the nation's development.



There are two government schools in the nearby villages- Kathera, Madwa and kesaripura. FSL is taking various initiatives to improve the infrastructural development of these schools. FSL has contributed fans, chairs, electronic items in last years and keep donating free books and stationeries to the School for better understanding and to give a basic infrastructure to learn.

Keeping in mind all the necessities and basic facilities with which all schools should be equipped mentioned in India's Right to Education Act, FSL has also contributing in increasing various amenities for the school, including toilets to maintain the proper sanitation, and a boundary wall to set the dimensions of the School.

FSL assists government schools in its areas of operation with not only meeting these requirements but also with enhancing such facilities by contributing in construction of a playground which is made on a very innovative concept of using waste tyres, painted with different colors so that students can easily learn to identify colors.

INFRASTRUCTURAL DEVELOPMENT



Infrastructure is the key enabling conditions in improving the quality of life of the communities. It not only helps in contributing to better living conditions but also accelerates faster movement of goods and services resulting in economic growth.

Being a key catalyst of social progress and sustainable development, developing sustainable rural infrastructure is a cornerstone of our CSR work. Creating the necessary supportive infrastructure, for sustainable healthcare, education and livelihood development is the primary motive of FSL. The primary areas of intervention in this context include:

1. Repairing of Bridge at Kathera Village.
2. Repairing of Roads at Kathera Village.
3. Infrastructure for support of Schools.
4. FSL has also made contributions for construction of Community Centre for Sarpanch of Panchayat, Kathera Villages, which can be multi used for conducting medical camps, organizing panchayat meetings and training sessions for villagers.



FSL has contributed significantly towards the forward and backward linkages of villages in the areas of operation by building all weather roads. Several peripheral schools have been renovated or upgraded with the construction of boundary walls, additional classrooms, buildings, toilets etc. Several other activities have been carried out on the existing water bodies in order to create the requisite sustainable water infrastructure for the people living nearby.

PROMOTION OF ART, CULTURE & HERITAGE



FSL also work towards preserving the rich heritage, art and culture of India for its future generations and makes conscious efforts to ensure its continuity and enhance avenues for livelihood of traditional artisans and craftsmen.

FSL has been regularly contributing towards the Bundeli Utsav, which is a cultural festival organized to promote the Bundeli folk arts, culture and to maintain the cultural heritage. In other words, opportunities are being given to the upcoming and talented performers to show their talent in this festival.



FSL contributed in various festivals celebrations like Sant Ravidas Jayanti, kavi sammelan in the village of Kathera and also donated to many Organisations like Seher and Srajan- the Spark foundation which promotes and nurture cultural heritage through ghazals, classical vocals, instrumental music etc.



FSL has also contributed in construction of Hanuman Temple in the nearby villages on the request of Panchayat, so that people of a particular community can come over there and worship under one roof. Another objective is to protect the religious outlook of the villagers.

OTHER CONTRIBUTIONS

FSL also contributed in various other sectors like promotion of sports and ensuring environmental sustainability, etc. To the commitment of FSL other following sustainable community development projects were taken up by the Company:



1. Contribution to Cricket Club for various Cricket Tournaments. The objective is to help those talented and dedicated players who can not afford to join the Club and also to improve the facilities for amateur players.

2. Donation to Basaman Mama Gauvansh for promotion of Animal Welfare. Their objective is to provide a protective shelter for cattle under one roof.

Through the protection of animals in Gaushala, villagers can be benefitted with the fresh cow milk.



3. Donation to Bharat Ke Veer for homage and support to India's Bravehearts. It is a registered trust for providing a platform to all the citizens to contribute and provide assistance to the families of martyred paramilitary personnel.

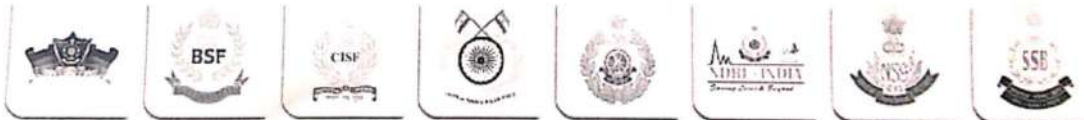
